CALL TO ORDER

APPROVAL – GA POWER LIGHTING AGREEMENT – PARKING LOT

INCREASE – LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX

Mayor Altznauer advised the council the local option sales tax percentage had changed from 4.00 % to 4.33 %. He said the LOST percentage is based on population. He said state law requires renegotiation of the percentages every ten years.

Tony Sells made motion to authorize the Mayor the sign agreement for the Local Option Sales Tax. Adam Beckstine seconded, all voted in favor and motion carried.
